



All Metal Polish

Instructions:

- 1 Clean surface from coarse dirt to avoid scratches.
- 2 Apply a small amount of polish to the surface.
- 3 Gently rub the polish over the metal surface with a clean cloth until a black residue appears.
- 4 Hard rubbing is not necessary and can reduce chrome layer.
- 5 Buff off residue with terry cloth or micro-fiber towel.

Attention: Do not use on gold plated, anodized, painted or clear-coated surfaces! It is normal to see a black residue on your cloth as you polish the metal. If you do not see this residue, STOP! It is not a polishable metal.

Precautionary Measures: Use only as directed. Wash thoroughly after handling. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

First Aid: Eye contact: If easy to do, remove contact lenses, if worn. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
